**The Palm Springs Unified School District** (PSUSD) serves approximately 21,000 students. All PSUSD schools are Title 1 schools, which serve high-need student populations. The district's students are 79% Hispanic. 34% are classified as English Learners, with Spanish being the primary language. And 97% of the district's

students are classified as socioeconomically disadvantaged. The Foundation for the Palm Springs Unified School District is a 501c3 nonprofit that raises funds for school-based programs that district budgets won't cover.

## How will this Auction SAVE The ARTS?

By partnering with Julien's Auctions, The Foundation for PSUSD can raise the necessary dollars to keep the arts in schools. Research has demonstrated that children who are exposed to the arts score higher on standardized tests, graduate at increased rates, are better problem-solvers, and are overall more engaged citizens. COVID-19 has devastated school budgets. Government incentives and extra financing is being limited to COVID support like handwashing stations, PPE gear, ventilation, and classroom technology. PSUSD has used funding to serve over 7 million meals during COVID, and to provide students with remote learning resources like laptops, school supplies, desks, and chairs.

## What Can I Donate?

Go through your closet or storage unit to find a piece of memorabilia or a rarity of some kind. One item from YOUR spectacular collection of iconic or meaningful fashions, costumes, and accessories could raise enough money to supply an entire elementary school with musical instruments.
